Bankhaus Lampe wins silver Victoria award in Vienna

Düsseldorf/Vienna 16.05.2014 – Bankhaus Lampe was awarded the silver Victoria at the 26th International Corporate Film Festival in Vienna yesterday for its image film in the Trade Fair/Events category. The Grand Prix Victoria is open to German-language corporate films from Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Liechtenstein and South Tyrol.

In this competition, producers and companies may submit corporate films in 16 broadly varied categories. These include traditional corporate and marketing films, tourism and trade fair films as well as TV business documentaries and web videos. More than 320 productions entered the competition this year.

After the first round, 63 films were shortlisted and awarded the silver Victoria. In a second round on 15 May, the films were assessed by an international jury of experts. The finalists in each category were awarded golden Victoria awards, and the best among the winners received the competition's highest accolade - the Grand Prix Victoria.

The Corporate Film Festival has been held every two years since 1962, and it has been organised by the Austrian Film Service since 2004. The winners are awarded silver and golden "Prix Victoria" awards, and the overall winner receives the "Grand Prix Victoria".
